DESCRIPTION

Züküdla is the exclusive distributor for Grober® Nutrition's line of ZooGro milk replacers for young exotic mammals. We recognize that proper nutrition during an animal's first weeks of life is critical for their development and long-term health. Mother's milk is always the best form of nutrition but if you need to artificially rear a newborn take comfort in the knowledge that you are using the most complete handfeeding program available to meet their daily nutritional requirements. All ZooGro milk replacers, manufactured by Grober® Nutrition are completely balanced, nutritionally sound and quality assured.

FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS / WHAT YOU WILL NEED

Measure	Mix	Add	Feed
165g of powder per liter of solution	Mix powder with 0.5L warm water (60oC) for 3 minutes using whisk or paint mixer.	0.4 liters of cold water and mix for 1 minute	Feed at body temperature (38-40oC).

COLOSTRUM: Start feeding ZooGro species appropriate milk replacers once newborn has received colostrum. Newborns should be fed maternal colostrum (mother's first milk) in the first 24 hours. This will help provide protection against future infections, particularly if the colostrum is fed before 12 hours. If the mother's colostrum is not available, the second option is colostrum from the same species, cow's colostrum (bison, camel, elephant, fawn, moose, yak) or goat's colostrum (camel, llama, alpaca). If no colostrum is available, use a commercial colostrum replacer product.

FEED INTAKE: Typically young animals require 10-15% of their bodyweight daily. Quantities offered should be adjusted to weight, increasing gradually from birth (up to 18%BW for fawn and moose) to weaning (10%BW after 6wks). The quantity of milk replacer fed to the calf will vary depending on health, size and availability of mother's milk. Weigh animal regularly to ensure that milk intake is adequate.

FEEDING FREQUENCY: Frequent feeding of small amounts will decrease the chances of digestive upsets. Spread daily intake over 8 feedings daily the 1st week and reduce by one feeding daily each week so they are receiving 1 feeding per day from 8 weeks until weaning. Any change in the feeding schedule should be done with judgement, according to growth, size and stool consistency.

FEEDING BEHAVIOR: Offer ZooGro Milk replacers in a bottle with an appropriately sized nipple or in an open bucket when animals are old enough

to drink by themselves (generally older than 2 weeks). Do not leave the milk in an open bucket for more than 2 hours.

URINATION/DEFECATION: Young animals often need assistance to help urinate and defecate for first 2-3 wks of life. Using a warm, moist cloth massage over the anal area and perineum while the animal is nursing, until they urinate and/or defecate. You must be persistent, this is very important to an animal's well-being.

WEANING: If a starter ration is available, offer small quantities daily. Offer good quality roughage (leafy material) and/or pasture on a free choice basis. Weaning should take place only when animal is consuming other types of solids on a regular basis.

WATER: Fresh, clean water should always be available, particularly when consuming a significant amount of solids.

SANITATION: Clean all feeding utensils and equipment after each feeding: rinse in lukewarm water, wash with a detergent in hot (80oC) water, rinse with clean water (ideally a weak 5-10% bleach solution) and dry thoroughly with a clean towel.

ILLNESS: Consult your veterinarian for any signs of disease, fever, parasites etc.
